



# Short-Term Mission Opportunities

## LOCAL CHURCH PARTNERSHIP

### American Peoples

Bring teams and work alongside a local church to reach their neighborhood. This can be done through a wide variety of avenues, including door-to-door and home-visit evangelism, home Bible studies, children's ministry (VBS), preaching, teaching Sunday School, sharing personal testimonies, sports clinics, English classes, social action, music, art, school visits, training leaders and teachers, facilitating Celebrate Recovery, etc. The type of work that can be done is truly limitless, as long as it is strategic to planting and growing churches.

## AMERICAS CONNECT

### American Peoples

Does your church have a heart to see an unreached people group come to know the hope of Jesus? Americas Connect is an opportunity to receive training and hands-on experience during a short-term trip as you learn how to do missions in a healthy way. You will be encouraged to take these skills and go deeper in missions engagement, partnering long-term with a missionary team to reach an unreached people or place in the Americas.

## ADVANCE 103

### American Peoples

Help us engage 103 new unreached peoples and places by the end of the decade. You will be involved in gaining entry to people groups by prayerwalking, outreach events, door-to-door visits, etc. As the Lord leads, you will share the gospel, leading to discipleship one on one or in small groups, healthy church planting, and leadership development.

## CONFERENCE CHILDCARE

### Central Asian Peoples

Help new personnel get equipped for ministry by providing childcare during their training meetings. Bring a team for nine days, serving new missionaries' children while their parents learn the ropes of living and serving in their new city.

## CULTURE AND LANGUAGE EXCHANGE

### Central Asian Peoples

Go into rural areas that have never heard the gospel through an English homestay program. Through our team's English business, we want to send native English speakers to stay in a village for several days at a time and provide English learners with an opportunity to practice. This will connect rural areas with believers while also connecting them to our business.

## BIBLE STORY TEAM

### Deaf Peoples

Deaf best understand biblical truth through signed stories. Bring a team to help us teach and encourage local Deaf believers as well as to engage Deaf non-believers through presenting clear and accurate Bible stories using sign language.

## PRAYERWALKING TEAM

### Deaf Peoples

Come and join our team to pray for God to open opportunities for us to share the gospel and make Deaf disciples all over this country. We recognize that as we pray for Deaf in specific areas, he prepares hearts and minds to receive the truth. Your team will pray for specific areas in preparation for us to share the gospel in those same areas.



## LIFTING THE VEIL

### Deaf Peoples

Bring a team of volunteers and work alongside Deaf national believers as they share the gospel. Participate in drama, Scripture storying, sharing the gospel, prayerwalking, and leadership training. All of this will help our team evangelize, make disciples, and plant churches among Deaf in this country.

## ENGLISH TEACHER

### East Asian Peoples

Spend a week to two months teaching English to missionary candidate students at various training centers in East Asia. These centers are preparing candidates to serve in various countries in Africa, the Middle East, Central Asia, East Asia, and Southeast Asia, and English is an important bridge language for them to know. By teaching these candidates at least survival English, you can help reduce stresses that are unique to missionaries in language adaptation.

## THEOLOGICAL TRAINER

### East Asian Peoples

Come help us train up strong, biblical church leaders. Due to the increased security concerns we have in country, it has become more imperative to train trainers and mobilize them to teach church leaders. We want to enlist a small amount of people who can go deep to provide these opportunities. We have materials that we already use to help assist your preparation to train leaders who will train future pastors and church planters.

## DIGITAL RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT

### East Asian Peoples

Are you skilled at building websites or apps? We could use your help. We are currently deeply connected to local partners who are responsible for planting hundreds of churches and sharing the gospel with hundreds of thousands of people. In the past, we did lots of face-to-face training and still do, but on a limited basis. With security tightening, we need alternate ways of delivering training and resources. We want to develop more apps, partner with online training platforms, and seek creative solutions. We need people with this expertise to come work with us.

## NATIONAL BAPTIST PARTNERSHIP

### European Peoples

Baptists in this country are seeking to evangelize more broadly, make disciples, engage domestic unreached people groups, train new leaders, plant churches, send missionaries, and strengthen the health of their existing churches and seminaries. They're asking for partners—come and join them to reach their nation.

## REACHING THE LOST

### European Peoples

Bring your teams and partner with us in our strategy, either in the capital city or in rural areas. We need teams that can help reach young professionals through English, do evangelism in rural areas, engage farmers, and teach new farming techniques. We also need teams to work in refugee camps to reach the displaced.

# Short-Term Mission Opportunities

## MEDICAL MISSIONS

### European Peoples

There are thousands of displaced people in small and large cities throughout the eastern part of this country. Medical missions would provide an opportunity to gather people, and while they wait for medical services, they can hear the gospel. Medical personnel would be able to hear and pray for their concerns.

## EVANGELISM AND PRAYER TEAM

### Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples

Come partner with field workers and nationals to enter into new areas of the city and begin conversations. You will also assist with ESL classes, which strengthen the presence and legitimacy of long-term field workers. Most in the city have never heard the gospel, so you will have opportunities to boldly share.

## SCRIPTURE DISTRIBUTION AND EVANGELISM

### Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples

We long to see these people engaged with the gospel. Come and focus your efforts on reaching them through Scripture portions and face-to-face evangelism. We are hoping to extend gospel presence and witness outside of the capital in the coming years and hope to find opportunities that will allow workers to access these groups on a regular basis.

## HEALTHCARE AND EDUCATION

### Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples

Come alongside us as we work to gain access to populations of displaced peoples. We share the gospel through healthcare and education projects, then follow up and begin discipling. We need churches that would be dedicated to doing whatever is necessary to work alongside us among these peoples. This could be through prayer or through providing medical professionals, educational specialists, or others who could help with children or adult education.

## CAMP AND CONFERENCE CENTER VOLUNTEER

### Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples

Help us run a facility where the gospel is shared and disciples and leaders are made. We are looking for volunteers who will help to do basic maintenance, housekeeping, and other services to host camps and conferences. There are also opportunities to be involved in discipleship. This is a specific request for two months or longer. Skills in maintenance, groundskeeping, and/or housekeeping are sought for this project.

## SERVICE PROJECTS

### Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples

Bring your group and help us with service projects in different towns, cities, and national parks to open doors for the gospel. In a land where Christianity has always been seen as a threat or a persecutor, goodwill and service projects help locals to welcome the love of our Messiah. You will work alongside some of our long-term personnel. Each project will be unique and will have a specific purpose associated with it.



## **PRAYER JOURNEY**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Come for a week to journey and pray with us for people and places in our area. Join us as we ask the Lord of the Harvest for wisdom, faith, and boldness as we labor in his fields.

## **LONDON BRIDGES**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Sow the gospel broadly in central London among Northern African and Middle Eastern peoples by distributing Arabic New Testaments and other resources. We will train you on how to share the gospel and answer major objections from non-believers. This summer project includes participants from different organizations and various parts of the world.

## **PROJECT NORTHERN LIGHTS**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Join us on the ground as we get the gospel to people from closed places by connecting with travelers passing through a key urban center. The goal is to give those travelers access to the Word so that we can one day change the spiritual landscape of their homelands.

## **TOURISM PLATFORM ASSISTANT**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Come work at our tourism site, which welcomes more than twenty thousand visitors per year. Our goal is to reintroduce God's chosen people to a covenant relationship with the Messiah. We're asking for a minimum two-month commitment.

## **ANIMAL CLINIC TEAM**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Animals are a massive part of the lives of the rural, majority-Muslim people group that our team lives and works among. Alongside a veterinarian, we are able to use animal clinics to access rural families. Volunteers allow our team and local partners to be free to interact and share the gospel with those who attend. These teams also help us treat and care for our platforms' herds. These clinics are an integral part of our strategy as we access the lost, share the gospel, and plant churches.

## **LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT TEACHER**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Each year, twenty-five Muslim-background believers are selected to participate in a leadership development program for the purpose of training those who display the potential to lead and build up the local church. We are seeking available, high-quality teachers to encourage and equip these leaders. The content includes Old Testament, New Testament, hermeneutics, and theology.

## **PRAYER RETREAT**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Twice a year we gather with our most faithful, fruitful local friends and spend time encouraging and equipping them for the purpose of making disciples and planting churches. During this time, we bring them to a safe place and encourage fun, fellowship, and refreshment. We are seeking volunteers to assist our team in one of these retreats. The team may lead team-building activities or VBS for the children, serve the families, pray, and possibly assist with training.

# Short-Term Mission Opportunities

## **BUNKHOUSE CONSTRUCTION**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Our team is able to live and work among a rural people group thanks to a for-profit dairy farm that we own and operate. This platform provides a quality product to the community and visas for our team, and we hope it will one day provide funding to support our ministry and humanitarian projects. Come help us complete a bunkhouse for interns, volunteers, and teammates to use when in the countryside. Housing is difficult to acquire and retain, and this bunkhouse will ensure that we have sufficient and secure housing in the future.

## **LONG-TERM PARTNERSHIP**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Come partner with us and take on the task of engaging one of the people groups in our area. Your church will be a part of our greater team but will be focused on a smaller people group that does not yet have a healthy church planting movement.

## **COVERING THE PLAINS FOR CHRIST**

### **South Asian Peoples**

Empower and encourage local partners to do the six elements of the missionary task well—entry, evangelism, discipleship, church formation, leadership development, and exit. Help them own that responsibility so they will train others to do the same and no longer have a need for foreigners to see these tasks completed.

## **CITY WARDEN**

### **South Asian Peoples**

Come adopt a ward of our city and help us plant a church there. As a “warden,” your church would help us reach your part of the city by specifically and consistently praying for your ward and bringing teams to share the gospel and strengthen believers. Resources will be provided by our team.

## **SHARING WITH PAKISTANIS IN EUROPE**

### **South Asian Peoples**

Pakistanis need the gospel, and we need you to come alongside us to reach them—starting with the Pakistanis who live in southern Europe. Our strategy is to share boldly with them in Europe so that they may multiply disciples and send people back to their home country to share the gospel and plant churches there.

## **REACHING BANGLADESHIS IN ROME**

### **South Asian Peoples**

Help us reach Bangladeshis by making disciples of Bangladeshi immigrants in Rome. Your team can share openly and boldly in Italy and engage Bangladeshis in discovery Bible studies with the hopes that disciples there will one day send church planting teams back to Bangladesh.



## **PRESCHOOL OUTREACH**

### **Southeast Asian Peoples**

Come work alongside us in developing our preschool program, from teacher training to improved facilities. Short-term teams can assist at the preschool by bringing a five-day VBS in the summers for our students and teachers. This could include music, Bible stories, crafts, and recreation. Not only will you influence the students who go home and tell the stories to their families, you will have a chance to meet and get close to teachers who have not accepted Christ. About a third of the preschool teachers are not believers yet.

## **SPORTS CLINICS**

### **Southeast Asian Peoples**

Situated in the mountains of Southeast Asia is a small sports complex serving soccer and basketball enthusiasts of all ages. If you're excited about playing and coaching soccer or basketball, love having fun, and are ready for the Father to use you to reach people who have never heard the good news, then come join our team! This summer we're looking for teams to come lead short-term sports clinics for local children and young adults who want to improve their athletic abilities.

## **MEDICAL TEAM**

### **Southeast Asian Peoples**

Got a passion for medical missions? Bring a team to help us train the medical staff at a hospital and nursing college. They need practical and spiritual training—in medical skills and in how to evangelize. Team members also would help with health screenings in villages and a clinic while sharing the gospel.

## **DOOR-TO-DOOR EVANGELISM**

### **Southeast Asian Peoples**

Want to share the hope of Christ in a dark place? We need teams to partner with local believers and translators to go out visiting from house to house, sowing the gospel broadly. Team members may also be asked to speak in local churches. While you're here, you might want to consider "adopting" a local church for future prayer support and encouragement.

## **JOB SKILLS TRAINING**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Come teach job skills to women who are looking for a way to provide for their family after leaving an abusive situation. This is a growing town with a copper mine that has provided a lot of income for many homes, but with the increase in income came the increase of alcohol abuse and domestic violence. You can help provide a means of self-sustainability through a new marketable job skill.

## **CONNECTING WITH ENGLISH SPEAKERS**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Thousands of people have moved to this area to work in copper mines. They speak English, and they've never heard the gospel. Our national partners are doing well at reaching the locals with local languages, but they struggle to connect with people who prefer English. Most of the churches that are making an effort to reach English speakers are preaching false gospels and leading people astray. Your evangelism efforts will be used to start international churches in these towns. This can easily turn into recurring trips to strengthen and disciple the new churches as well.

# Short-Term Mission Opportunities

## **BOLSTERING EVANGELISM**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Help plant a new church in a spiritually dark area. The neighborhood is a cultural stronghold with potential to influence the greater community. We need partners to bolster our team's evangelism efforts and help us saturate this neighborhood with the gospel. This will help enable us to follow up, make disciples, and form churches.

## **EQUIPPING THE CHURCH**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Come facilitate a leadership development or theological education seminar for local churches. Invest in leaders who will carry the mission forward for years to come. Topics may include hermeneutics, Old or New Testament survey, or expository preaching. This opportunity is for spiritually mature leaders and gifted teachers.

## **TRAINING DISCIPLES**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Our strategy is this—seek out lost people, invite them to accept the hope of Christ, then immediately begin discipling them. Come alongside us as we train new believers to be competent and confident to share their faith and disciple others.

## **REACHING YOUTH WITH ENGLISH**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Teach ESL out of our community center. This opportunity helps boost our church planting efforts by building relationships with people in priority communities. Come for two months, six months, or a year and make an impact. This is a great opportunity for gap year students.

## **SHARING JESUS IN MARKET TOWNS**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

In this area, people groups come from villages to market towns to sell or purchase goods. Partner with us to plant churches there with the hope that people from unreached areas will come to the market and hear the gospel. We need churches to do prayer walks in the area, go along with our local partners and share the gospel door to door, and help train our local partners.

## **ENGAGING REMOTE VALLEYS**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

In this part of the world, a people group in need of the gospel is spread across remote valleys. Your church can come and adopt one valley to engage with the gospel. You would be trained, equipped, and released to share the gospel, make disciples, plant churches, and train up leaders in your valley. Invest here over the long haul and watch how God moves.

## Journeyman

DURATION: 2 YEARS

### DESCRIPTION

Journeyman are recent college graduates with a passion to take the gospel to unreached peoples around the globe. They sign on for two to three years and are fully funded by the IMB. Journeyman must be between the ages of twenty-one and twenty-nine and have completed an undergraduate degree. They participate full time in the missionary task.

Team Associates can participate full time or part time in the missionary task.

# Journeyman Opportunities

## **URBAN RESEARCHER**

### **American Peoples**

Serve on the front lines of engagement of unreached peoples and areas in a city of twenty-two million. Much like an army scout locating targets and calling in the troops, your task will be to research, locate, and form relationships with these targets to prepare the way for teams to engage them.

## **UNIVERSITY STUDENT CATALYST**

### **American Peoples**

Future leaders are accessible now in their formative college years through university ministries. With more than a million university students in this megacity, there is a great need to reach the majority who do not know Jesus.

## **VILLAGE EXPLORER**

### **American Peoples**

Explore and research indigenous communities in jungles, mountains, deserts, and beaches to identify persons of influence, learn essential worldview keys for unreached peoples, and look for entryways for church planting among the unreached.

## **NATIONAL PARTNER COORDINATOR**

### **American Peoples**

Help local believers develop their English skills to interpret for U.S. partners and mobilize a growing number of college students for the missionary task.

## **STUDENT STRATEGY TEAM MEMBER**

### **American Peoples**

Impact the nations by mobilizing and equipping young people to make disciples and serve among the unreached. This is the perfect job for you if you have experience in collegiate or youth ministry or have served as a summer or semester missionary. It is also a great opportunity for those who are passionate about mobilizing and equipping young people in the U.S. and Latin America to take the gospel to the nations. Skills in written and verbal communication, as well as in planning, are important to be successful in this job.

## **UNIVERSITY STUDENT WORKER**

### **Central Asian Peoples**

Engage university students in an upwardly mobile capital city. About fifty thousand students a year come to this city with open minds and hearts from small towns and villages across the country. Meet, build relationships with, and make disciples of these students. Our team's mission is to make disciples of all Central Asian peoples in fulfillment of the Great Commission, resulting in sound, biblical, reproducing churches.

## **CHURCH PLANTER**

### **Central Asian Peoples**

Work alongside an existing team to continue to facilitate the current work in a vastly unreached city. Work with experienced church planters in accordance with the strategies already in place on the field. Reach the unreached. Go where the need is greatest.



## **CHILDREN'S MEDICAL CLINIC SUPERVISOR**

### **Central Asian Peoples**

Oversee an existing pediatric medical clinic in a women's prison. The children's ages range from newborn to six years old. The clinic has one local doctor and one local nurse who visit three times per week to conduct wellness checks and prescribe medicine for sick children. You would manage the existing staff, upgrade and maintain children's records, and nurture relationships with the mothers.

Communication will primarily be in the local language once formal language training is completed. This job is open to single females only.

## **WOMEN'S PRISON VOCATIONAL TRAINING SUPERVISOR**

### **Central Asian Peoples**

Oversee an existing training program at the local women's prison. The program includes tailoring, baking, and cosmetology, with additional training in literacy, English, and aerobic exercise. You would need to oversee and participate in the training alongside local instructors, as well as teach English.

Communication will primarily be in the local language once formal language training is completed. This job is for a single female.

## **ENGLISH TEACHER**

### **Central Asian Peoples**

Use your teaching skills to help a church planting team comprised of both IMB workers and personnel from partner agencies. There is an ever-increasing demand here for native English teachers. The platform of an English center provides workers the ability to develop a credible identity in the eyes of locals. This identity will open the door for you to meet and develop relationships with the goal of sharing the gospel, discipling and encouraging, and supporting church planting.

## **SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPER**

### **Central Asian Peoples**

Assist a venture solutions coach to develop business plans and launch new businesses that provide credible identities needed by personnel to access their people groups. Live an intentional cross-cultural life that provides opportunities to develop relationships for the purpose of sharing the gospel through Bible stories and your living example of a walk with Jesus.

## **CHURCH PLANTER**

### **Deaf Peoples**

Do you have a heart for those who are Deaf and live and die in darkness, without the hope of the gospel?

Join a team and help multiply churches by training Deaf to be leaders in existing church plants, discipling believers who are not yet in churches, and evangelizing those who live in unreached areas.

## **CHURCH PLANTER**

### **East Asian Peoples**

Join us and share hope through direct evangelism, discipleship of local believers, church planting, and church growth and development among dozens of college campuses. You will also study local language.

## **UNIVERSITY CAMPUS CATALYST**

### **East Asian Peoples**

Do you have a passion to share the gospel with the multitudes of university students in this part of the world? Are you challenged to be used by God to start a church planting movement among them? Come join a pioneering team to reawaken the hearts of these young people for Christ!

# Journeyman Opportunities

## **SPORTS EVANGELIST**

### **East Asian Peoples**

Use your love of God and sports to impact peoples' lives to grow in their faith and disciple local believers. Encourage them to lead their brothers and sisters to reach and impact communities and the most unreached peoples of this country. Be involved in regular evangelism, discipleship, and leadership development, with the purpose of mobilizing believers to pray, focus on, and go to an unreached people group.

## **STUDENT STRATEGIST**

### **European Peoples**

Engage more than one hundred thousand students by teaching English and business classes, delivering TED-style lectures, and offering many other opportunities that are attractive to college students. By connecting with them in this way you will begin gospel-centered relationships. You will also be part of our church planting strategy by leading small groups, discipling believers in group and one-to-one situations, and training leaders.

## **BOARDING SCHOOL TEACHER**

### **European Peoples**

Come teach or serve as support staff at an internationally recognized missional school. In the past, staff members have worked either in teaching positions or support staff (accounting, athletic trainer, chaplain, etc.). Each teacher, once approved by the IMB, will need to complete an online application with the school. ## **BUSINESS ANALYST**

### **European Peoples**

Would you like to proclaim the gospel to both southeast European peoples and business travelers from around the globe? We're looking for people with backgrounds in business management, marketing, graphic design, or web design/programming to join our team. We are engaging the local business community and the community at large with a Business as Mission strategy centered around a for-profit consulting company that offers a co-working space as one of its services.

## **HIKING DISCIPLER**

### **European Peoples**

The people who live here endure extreme hardships and hold firmly to a traditional Christianity devoid of the true gospel. We have to be available and meet needs physically and spiritually in order to have the right to be heard. We engage the people in many different ways to gather and group them—sports, fitness, English, hiking, and other common interests. We partner directly with like-minded churches in the country to begin new churches. This is accomplished through training and discipleship of church leaders, helping coordinate outreach, and mentoring young pastors and lay leaders. Here it is still not uncommon to have a whole household pray to receive Christ when given the opportunity.



## **YOUNG GENERATION EVANGELIST**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Live and minister in a heavily Muslim area of town where no other missionaries live. Use your gifting and talents (sports, art, music, etc.) to gain access to and share the gospel with North Africans. Take classes to learn French (and possibly Arabic) and look for opportunities to teach English while actively seeking to establish relationships with students who are of North African origin. The goal of building these relationships will be to actively share the gospel and to start groups that form reproducing churches.

## **ENGLISH TEACHER**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Join a team to engage Muslims in this modern country. You and your teammates will work in an institute as English teachers for adults. Arabic study is provided at the same institute.

## **RELATIONAL EVANGELIST**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Looking to live on the edge? Come live among a rural people group in North Africa. The people are very hospitable, loyal, and connected to each other. To become part of their lives requires attending weddings, visiting neighbors, greeting them for holidays, and drinking a LOT of sweet, strong tea. Many men enjoy being outdoors and will go on picnics to the beach or desert to spend time together. The hours you spend together will give you opportunities to share about what Christ has done for you.

## **CHURCH PLANTER**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Do you desire to share the gospel where it's never been heard? Are you ready to be a bold evangelist among Muslims? Join our team in North Africa in a region with about three million people that until recently had almost no gospel witness. Your team leaders will train and mentor you in evangelism and discipleship skills as you connect with people in our area using your unique gifts, skills, and abilities. You must be a self-starter and passionate about sharing the gospel with those who have not heard. You must be flexible and a hard worker, but also ready to have a lot of fun.

## **TESOL TEACHER**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Use your background in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) to train elementary and secondary teachers as well as students and professionals in TESOL methodology. You will also work with the director of the program to develop and refine a curriculum to achieve the objectives of the project. While you work at strategic locations in the city and in the countryside, you will share the gospel in homes, follow up with believers who need to be disciplined, and plant churches that will reproduce.

## **TEACHER**

### **Northern African and Middle Eastern Peoples**

Come teach in the elementary, middle, or high school at a local academy. The responsibilities are to teach as required during the school year and be involved in extra activities according to the academy's leadership requests. Learn language and culture while helping to administrate and implement an ongoing water project that provides permanent access to this people group. The people group is made up of rural subsistence farmers who hold very tightly to and are controlled by their branch of orthodoxy. While claiming to follow God, they actually know very little of the Bible and most have no idea who Jesus truly is. Strive to engage the lost and train the existing believers so they can multiply.

## **CHURCH PLANTING STRATEGIST**

### **South Asian Peoples**

Every people group here is currently unreached—millions of people who have never once heard the name of Jesus. You would be the first person ever to share the gospel with many of them. Live among them, train believers to share their faith, and help build a strategy to reach the unreached.

## **WOMEN'S MINISTRY STRATEGIST**

### **South Asian Peoples**

This area is home to nearly sixty million women, and most of them don't know Jesus. You'll find them cooking over open fires, picking vegetables in roadside fields, and carrying heavy loads on top of their heads. You'll also find them working as teachers, business executives, and IT analysts. As a women's ministry strategist, you will join a team that partners with locals to find, train, and send out believers—especially women. Your goal will be to do whatever it takes to see the gospel spread through the women of the whole state.



## **CATALYTIC TRAINER**

### **South Asian Peoples**

The twenty million people in this South Asian country are truly unreached, with less than 1 percent believers among them. They are in darkness and under the power of the enemy. Your primary focus will be to seek God and work with your teammates to reach the people and help facilitate a church planting movement among them.

## **REFUGEE DIRECTOR**

### **South Asian Peoples**

Refugees in the area need hope, and they need resources. Your job will be to share the gospel among refugees while addressing their physical needs. Some of your duties will be to assess the current situation; develop a relationship with other relief workers; meet and work with key government officials; develop, direct, and delegate distribution projects; and teach believers how to be light and salt in a dark situation.

## **CHURCH PLANTER**

### **Southeast Asian Peoples**

Join a small team working among one of the largest unreached people groups in Southeast Asia. You will be responsible for evangelism, discipleship, and church planting for a large city, as well as for the surrounding provinces. This is a wonderful opportunity to stretch yourself and see God's hand move among a nominal Buddhist people who live in a country that is "closed" to the gospel. This is a new area of engagement, but there are already a small number of believers. We want to encourage the local church to grow and continue to reach out to new places.

## **TEAM LEADER**

### **Southeast Asian Peoples**

Want to help the gospel spread through new house churches? Work with our team of national evangelists and traditional Baptist churches to begin a movement that plants healthy house churches that multiply themselves.

## **CITY LEADER**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Every unreached people group in the country is represented in this city. Most of them are Muslim. Come cast vision, strategize, and lead in forming a team to target segments of the city with the gospel. This will be done in collaboration with local Baptist leaders, pastors, and believers. The vision is for churches to be planted in every ethnic group and to give these churches a vision of planting churches in their tribal homes.

## **THEOLOGICAL EDUCATION CATALYST**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

This country is poised to be the heart of the next great wave of missionary advance to the world. But to see this happen, we need more trained pastors, qualified theologians, and national missionaries to evangelize and disciple believers here and then be sent into the world. They need to be equipped with a biblically grounded gospel that will counter the prosperity gospel that has currently overtaken the country. Help strengthen the standards of missiology and sound theology at a school and be active in raising up the next generation of pastors and national missionaries.

# Long-Term Mission Opportunities

## **RURAL CHURCH DEVELOPMENT**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Someone needs to research and strategize how to reach this rural area with the gospel. Will that be you? In this role, you would work with mature believers to develop strategies for reaching their own people. You would also provide guidance to establish a church there, training believers to be biblical leaders who will continue the work after the team is gone.

## **STUDENT MINISTRY LEADER**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Are you a creative and hardworking leader with a passion for student ministry? Universities here draw from everywhere in East Africa and offer a rare opportunity to engage students when they are free to investigate new ideas. After they graduate, these students will be leaders in their home areas and throughout the world. Send them out with the gospel! We need someone who will lead a team to initiate and coordinate ministries across more than twenty campuses here.

## **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CATALYST**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

This is one of the fastest-growing cities in the world and one of the most strategic in West Africa. There are tremendous needs, and when physical needs are met, doors open wide to share the gospel. Your role will be vital in helping local churches discover how to meet those needs, effectively share the gospel, and see new healthy urban churches planted.

## **CHURCH PLANTER**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Build up a team to reach a heavily unreached region. Your work will begin primarily through building up the few local congregations by teaching, vision casting, and modeling the missionary task. You will also be involved personally in regular evangelism. As it is appropriate, you can use mercy ministries such as medical and dental clinics, disaster relief, and sustainable community development projects to go along with your evangelism, but as one seamless and integrated effort. The purpose is to begin to see reproducing churches established through the greater region.

## **PHYSICAL THERAPIST**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Use your skill set to open doors to share the gospel. In this area, healthcare strategies provide unique ways to reach the lost with the good news. You can use physical therapy as a way to evangelize, disciple, and encourage believers. In this role, you would assess and treat patients in a home-based setting as well as at a hospital.

## **SOCIAL MEDIA STRATEGIST**

### **Sub-Saharan African Peoples**

Often people picture the West Africa of mud huts, no electricity, no running water, and limited outside connection. While that does exist, it is shrinking. In the urban centers, people are connected. Social events are documented online, and communication takes place through apps. You will develop a comprehensive strategy that uses the preferred social media of West Africans for connecting, evangelism, discipleship, and grouping. Proper marketing techniques can open West Africans' eyes to the gospel, and a healthy social media presence can create entry points for our urban teams.

This is a focused time of training and cross-cultural preparation in a group environment. It is when you have the most concentrated time of learning, practice, and implementation you will experience before heading off to the field.

Following all of the assessment and training, your final step involves saying goodbye to family, friends, and church and beginning a new season of life and ministry in another culture alongside your missionary team.
