There is an entire people group of 2 million whose name means “journeying trader.” This group lives in Burkina Faso. These clever traders are an unreached, unengaged people group, which means there are VERY few Christians among them. Being Muslim is an important part of who they are. In fact, their Muslim identity affects everything — what they believe, what they do, what they drink, and even what they eat. While it would be very difficult for the Julia to believe the gospel, they are open to learning and interacting with other cultures.

Would you pray for the Julia to hear the gospel? Can you imagine if some heard and believed, and instead of trading goods for money they starting trading their old way of life for a new one? Also pray for Julia children, who, just like you, need Jesus. Maybe next time you make a trade with a friend, you stop and pray for the Julia! Their hearing and believing the gospel would be far better than any minifig you might score!
