

PRAY FOR THE ANTESAKA OF MADAGASCAR



Do you like to “move it, move it?” While you might be picturing a talking lion, hippo, giraffe and zebra, have you ever wondered what life on the island of Madagascar is really like? Did you know that there are actually people on the island, not just animals??

One of these groups of people is called the Antesaka. In fact, this people group is only found in Madagascar and numbers up to 1, 400, 000! They are currently an unreached people group, which means the majority of them have no way to hear about Jesus. While some of the Antesaka have moved to other parts of the island to find work, most of the Antesaka live on the Southeastern coast. They are pretty hard to get to. There are no roads to their villages so you either have to walk or go by boat to even meet them! Can you imagine how difficult it must be then to share the gospel with



them? Because they haven't heard the gospel yet they have their own traditional beliefs like worshiping their ancestors and other so-called spirits. It would be difficult for them to believe the truth of the gospel but not impossible! Romans 1:16 says that the gospel is the power of God for salvation!



Will you pray that someone will take the good news to the Antesaka and when they hear they will believe?
