THE RWANDESE OF TANZANIA



Rwandese refugees moved into Tanzania during years of internal conflict in Rwanda, including the mass genocide of 1994, when as many as 1 million people were murdered.

Now there are approximately 249,000 Rwandese residing in Tanzania. Their primary language is Kinyarwanda, and the complete Bible is available in their language. Most Rwandese adhere to Roman Catholicism. While there are a few evangelical believers among the Rwandese of Tanzania, there is currently no active church planting efforts among them.



Pray

- that displaced Rwandese will find a place of peace in their adopted home of Tanzania. Ask God to help them know they are His no matter where they live.
- that the evangelical believers will have boldness to share their faith with the many Tanzanians who do not know Christ. Intercede for them to have the courage to be missionaries in the regions to which they have relocated.
- that God will give favor to these Rwandese immigrants so that they can live and work legally in Tanzania.
