

PRAY FOR THE SONDE

OF THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC
OF THE CONGO



Have you ever watched a competitive volleyball game? It's pretty exciting. Usually there are six players on each side. The six players work together to make sure the ball doesn't hit the ground and to get the ball back over the net to the other team. To be really good at this sport, the team has to know each other well and each individual has an important part to play. They need each other to win.

Did you know that there is a very special team of six, that are not working together to play volleyball or any other sport for that matter. Instead, they are working together to take stories from the Bible and put them into their own language. These six men and women are some of the very few believers from the unengaged, unreached people group called the Sonde. They live in the Democratic Republic of Congo, or the DRC. Most of the Sonde live in darkness, suspicious of anyone who poses a threat to them or their way of life, including Christians, which makes it really difficult to share the gospel with them. Also, there is currently NO printed portion of the Bible in the Kisonde language.



Will you pray for the Sonde people? Pray that there will be some who want to hear the true gospel. Pray for the six Sonde believers, that they will know how to take stories from the Bible and communicate it in the Kisonde language, so that their own people can hear the same good news that has changed their lives. Pray that this team of six will grow to be sixty, six hundred, six thousand! May this small team grow so big that they are no longer known as an unreached people group.

Don't forget to pray for the Sonde children, too! Pray that one day they will get to hear these gospel stories and perhaps even have the whole bible in their own language.
