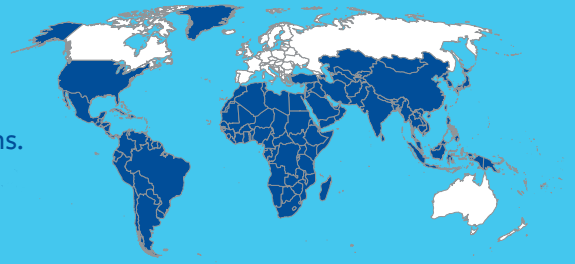


Europe

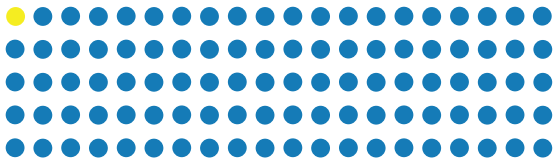

The **40/70 Window** describes an area of the world located between 40 and 70 degrees north of the equator that is increasingly post-Christian.
