### WHY SEND ASIAN AMERICAN MISSIONARIES?

1. Asian Americans who've recently moved to the U.S. maintain **strong social ties** with those in their home countries. Asian American Southern Baptists have **cultural and linguistic connections** to thousands of unengaged, unreached people groups around the world.
2. Asian Americans value harmony and interpersonal relationships. Asian American Southern Baptists **play a bridging role** to promote organizational oneness and multicultural team collaboration.
3. Almost all Southern Baptist Asian American congregations (96%) are in metro areas with **keen understanding of cities** where much of the world's unreached people live.

Asian churches are growing in number and depth across the Southern Baptist Convention, and our partnership is essential to fulfilling the Revelation 7:9 vision.

Cambodian, Chinese, Filipino, Hmong, Japanese, Korean, Laotian, Myanmar, Burmese, Thai, and Vietnamese congregations represent the Asian faces of the SBC, and many are active partners in the IMB's work of taking the gospel to the nations.

Revelation 7:9-10 says that there will be a great multitude from every nation, tribe, people and language. **Let's advance God's kingdom together.**
