



Personal Evangelism

All believers are called to share the gospel, but it can be a scary step of obedience for many people. As you prepare to lead your group on a mission trip, this can be a great opportunity to equip them to be disciple-makers not only overseas, but also right in your own harvest fields!

We recommend that you ask your missionary host for their preferred evangelism tool for their context. At the same time, we want to provide you with a few resources that your team can use right here at home as you prepare to go.

Gospel Sharing Tools

- **Care through prayer**
Sometimes starting the conversation is the hardest part. Many people find it helpful to simply start by saying, "We're out praying for our community today. Is there anything that we could pray about for you or your family? This conversation starter can lead to sharing your testimony and the good news of the gospel!"
- **My story**

- **3 Circles Gospel Tool**

As you come back together, provide a time of accountability, encouragement, and prayer for those you were able to share with. Celebrate their obedience to go and coach them in the areas where they may need help.
